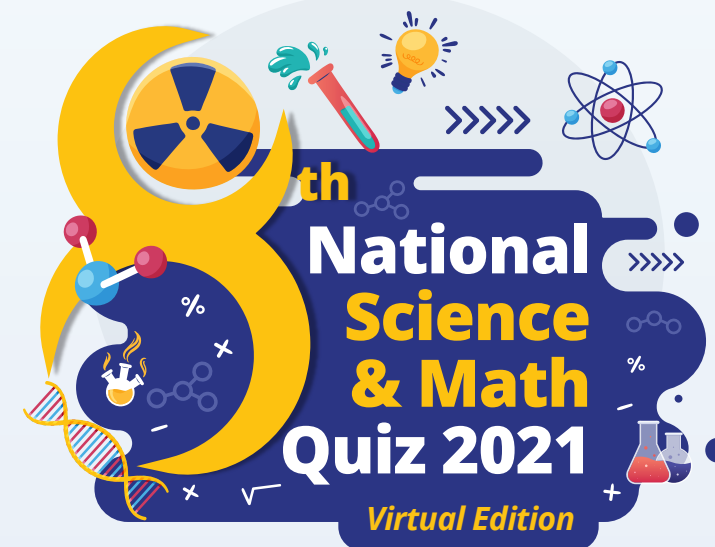

## Challenge Mechanics

The online quiz will be conducted in ENGLISH. The questions set for this challenge will be segregated into the following categories:  
a. Mathematics b. Biology c. Chemistry d. Physics

Questions MAY NOT be based on SPM/IGCSE curriculum only and will also cover Nutrition Science which is the theme for this year. This competition will be divided into the State and National Level Challenges.

## STATE LEVEL CHALLENGE

State Level Challenge will be conducted as an online MCQ quiz via Quizizz, comprising 60 multiple-choice questions (MCQs). Participants will sit for an individual online quiz and the duration is 60 minutes.

The online quiz will be conducted simultaneously in 13 states and the Federal Territories (KL, Putrajaya, and Labuan).

Instructions to access the online quiz will be sent via email one week prior to the State level challenge.

Top ten teams with the highest score from each state and the Federal Territories (KL, Putrajaya, and Labuan) will be short-listed to progress to the National Challenge.

### Rewards:

- Certificate of Participation is provided to each participant
- Certificates for each winning team (Champion, First Runner-up and Second Runner-up) of the State Challenge
- Certificate of Appreciation to all Teacher Advisors

## NATIONAL LEVEL CHALLENGE

The National Level Challenge will be conducted as an online MCQ quiz via Quizizz, comprising 50 multiple-choice questions (MCQs).

All participants will attempt questions simultaneously as a team in real-time as the questions are presented on-screen one by one.

There will be no "Back" button to reattempt questions once questions have passed.

Instructions to access the online quiz will be sent via email one week prior to the National level challenge.

### Rules and Regulations

1. This competition is open to all science stream Form 5 students and IGCSE students or equivalent.
2. The quiz will be conducted in English.
3. Each team should consist of three (3) students, under the supervision of their teacher.
4. Each successful registration will be followed by a confirmation email from the organiser.
5. Please make sure the registered email account is active.
6. The competition will be carried out on various digital platforms which require a coverage of internet network allowing high speed data transfer for the purpose of smooth audio or video conferencing. It is the participant's responsibility to ensure that this is in place before the competition takes place.
7. The Judges'/Organisers' decisions in all matters relating to the competition shall be final, absolute, and binding on the participants.
8. If at any time during or after the competition, a winner is found to have not complied with any of the Rules and Regulations, the Organisers reserve the right to cancel and/or recover the claimed prize at their sole discretion. In such a situation, the winning team will be disqualified, and the panel of judges will determine a new winning team.
9. Members of the winning team should be available for the post-competition production, recording and publicity of the competition, such as:
  - a. Interview (which shall be videotaped)
  - b. Taking of still photographs, audio or visual recording for promotions and publicity purposes.
10. The Organisers reserve the right to vary, postpone or reschedule the dates and venues of the competition or extend the competition period at their sole discretion, and to change the online platform as and when deemed necessary.
11. By participating in this competition, the contestants agree to and shall ensure that all team members, chaperones, and their respective institution's authorities agree to be bounded by the competition's Rules and Regulations.
