Our Story

Skateline traces its beginnings to June 1998 when founder Mr Felix Yeo attained an ICP Level 1 Certification from the International Inline Skating Association (IISA). He started teaching skating on a freelance basis in Singapore, and in April 1999, Skateline was incorporated as a sole proprietorship.

The first inline pro shop was opened in October that year to serve the needs of the growing skate community in the Island Republic. Today, there are six Skateline pro shops in Singapore, making it the first and largest integrated skate company in the region.

Skateline ventured into Malaysia in July 2005, with its first outlet in Taman Tun Dr Ismail, Kuala Lumpur. In May 2007, it opened its second Malaysian outlet in Queensbay Mall, Penang, as part of the happening new Roller Sports World, the largest inline and roller hockey rink in Malaysia. In June, its third outlet opened in Sungei Wang Plaza, Kuala Lumpu.

Skateline Skate School

Even after nine years, the skate school remains the core of Skateline's operations.

Skateline set the standards for inline skating instruction by adhering strictly to an international standard of instruction and, at the same time, promoting the use of full protective gear. It continues to be the only skate school in Asia to meet the stringent requirements of the Inline Certification Program International.

All our instructors are internationally certified with the IISA's Inline Certification Program (ICP). It is the only skate school in the world that boasts of three ICP examiners and more then 30 ICP-certified Instructors.

The school provides a structured program with four levels to take the beginner through to advance skating skills. Skateline's original inline-skate education program, the ICP-based Learn-To-Skate program, developed over four years since 1999, maps out the complete list of specific skills, which you will master as you advance through the program. There are also opportunities to start in exciting disciplines such as speed skating, marathon skating, inline hockey and slalom skating.
